Safety Patrol is a program to help students enter and exit the building as well as to monitor and ensure all students at Meadowbrook are safe. I know you all have seen the safety patrollers at their station with their bright yellow belts. Well that could be you. Any interested 3rd grader can be a safety patrol “shadow”. There are 2 shifts: morning and afternoon.
