Let's Talk! with Mrs. VanAsten, Speech-Language Pathologist

Ho-ho-hold the phone! It's December already? That came on out of the blue! For the month of December I think it's fun to talk about idioms. An idiom is simply a combination of words that have a different meaning from their literal meaning. People use idioms all the time (whether they know it or not). For some kids, understanding an idiom can be a grev area; they tend to be literal with what they hear and may not find the humor or the sarcasm in idioms. To help kids understand idioms, simply take the time to explain the meaning behind them - it's a piece of cake! For example, sometimes the holiday season can turn me into a *basket case* - meaning I can be so frazzled and excited that I may start acting like a crazy person! Idioms are fun to use, and are a great way to expand a child's receptive and expressive language skills. Go ahead, give it a shot. I'll bet your child gets a kick out of them!
