As part of our Immigration Unit, all third grade students will be immigrating to the United States through Ellis Island. We are setting up a simulation of Ellis Island in the Library Media Center, and we need your help!! Would you be available on Tuesday, January 9th 8:30 - 11:00 to help with the Ellis Island Quest? The students will be starting their journey at 9:00.

We are asking moms, dads, grandparents and others in our community to help us with this simulation as inspectors, investigators, or doctors. You would be given one of these roles on "Ellis Island" where you would pose questions to the students, check over their paperwork to be certain they have proper identification, or examine them briefly for any illnesses. We want to be certain that these new immigrant families do not carry disease; and that they are capable of doing a job
