New Year-Round Update process for parents to update family information online

- 1. Parent/Guardian will log into the PowerSchool Parent Portal
- Once in the portal, choose the appropriate student (changes will need to be done for each child listed in the account)
- Select InfoSnap Year Round Update on the left side under navigation. (This will take a couple seconds to populate the information that is currently in PowerSchool).
- 4. Once the student information is populated, the parent/guardian is free to change the appropriate information such as primary mailing name, contact#, address, mother/father/guardian information, and emergency contact information.
