Check out the lost and found racks when you are at school. We have Many coats already there plus hats and gloves.

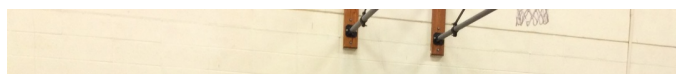


Leader of the Pack

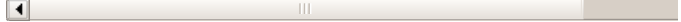


EMERGENCY CLOSINGS AND DELAYS
