Hello, and welcome to another wonderful school year at Meadowbrook Elementary! We are Katie VanAsten and Julie Heim and we are the Speech-Language Pathologists (SLP) for students at Meadowbrook Elementary school this year. As SLPs, we work with students who have diagnosed speech and language delays. These delays include articulation (speech sounds), grammar, expressive and receptive language, voice, or fluency (stuttering). While we get the privilege of working with many of the students that come to our school, we know there are more still that we do not get to meet. Language is such a large part of our lives, and we would like to take an opportunity each month to share what we hope will be some useful, easy tips for enhancing the speech and language skills of ALL students.

Mrs. VanAsten will be working with students in grade 3rd and 4th, while Mrs. Heim will be working with students in Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade. If you ever have questions about your child's speech and language development, please don't hesitate to give us a shout! We are happy to be a resource for all.
