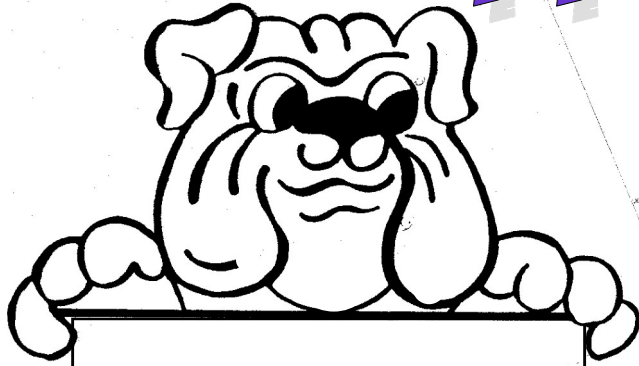

ALL GRADE LEVELS

Throughout the school year teachers may be requesting additional supplies for projects and activities.

KINDERGARTEN

Large school bag or backpack – labeled with name

1 pair of scissors—**labeled**

1 pencil box 5.5 x 8.5 x 2.5—**labeled**

1 set of headphones (no ear buds) straight plug -
labeled in a bag

These items will be shared among students.

10 jumbo glue sticks - Elmer's preferred

12 #2 Ticonderoga pencils – **sharpened**

1 pink eraser

4 boxes crayons - 24 count - Crayola preferred

4 black dry erase wide tip markers –Expo preferred

6 plastic, three pronged pocket folders (plain) – no trapper keeper folders 1 red, 1 purple, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 orange

1 box slider zip locking bags - Ziploc preferred

Last name A-M: gallon size

Last name N-Z: quart size

1 binder (1 inch) with a clear cover

1 watercolor paint - Crayola preferred

1 pack 3 x 3 size post-it notes -Last Name A-M

1 any type index cards—Last Name N-Z
